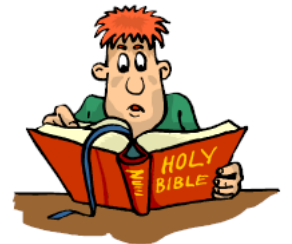

21-25 April

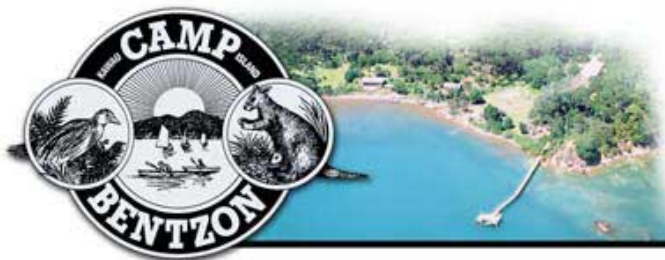

## LOCATION

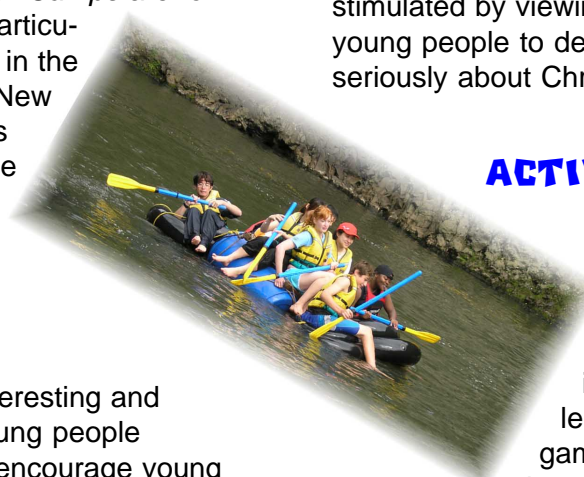
This year's Camp will be our fifth, and to mark this milestone we will be going to a special location: Kawau Island in the Hauraki Gulf! Camp Bentzon is situated amongst native native bush in its own bay; an idillic spot which will provide an excellent venue in unique surroundings.



## THE PROGRAMME

The Youth Camps provide a full programme of indoor and outdoor activities together with meetings for Bible teaching and discussion. In addition to teaching sessions, discussion will be further stimulated by viewing videos aimed at helping the young people to develop discernment and think seriously about Christianity.

## ACTIVITIES



A number of activities are planned, including confidence courses, bush walks, kayaking and possibly abseiling and sailing, as well as more leisurely indoor and outdoor games. There will also be ample time at the camp for informal interaction. All activities will be overseen by qualified and/or experienced leaders.

## TEACHING

The Chaplain is responsible for the Bible teaching during camp.
