## **YOUTH CAMP 07** 9<sup>th</sup> - 13<sup>th</sup> April

The annual Grace & Truth Youth Camps are for young people aged 13 – 19, particularly (but not exclusively) those Churches that are Baptistic and Reformed in New Zealand. The camp director is Fred Schaumkel, an Elder in the North Shore Baptist Reformed Church.

#### AIMS

- To provide an enjoyable, interesting and stimulating holiday for young people
- To present the Gospel and encourage young Christians in their walk with Jesus
- To provide an opportunity for friendships to be formed with young people from other Reformed Baptist churches and elsewhere

## LOCATION

This is the seventh camp we have held for our youth and we are returning to Camp Bentzon on Kawau Island in the Hauraki Gulf which has been an excellent venue for the past two years.



## THE PROGRAMME

The Youth Camps provide a full programme of indoor and outdoor activities together with meetings for Bible teaching and discussion. Large and small group discussions are aimed at helping the young people to develop discernment and think seriously about Christianity and issues which generally relate to youth today.

#### **ACTIVITIES**

A number of activities are planned, including confidence courses, bush walks, kayaking, sailing, fishing and possibly abseiling, as well as more leisurely indoor and outdoor games. There will also be ample time at camp just to sit around and chat.

All activities will be overseen by qualified and/or experienced leaders.

## **TEACHING**



The Chaplain is responsible for Bible teaching during camp. This year David Farr from Inglewood, Taranaki, will again be our Chaplain.

### CAMP FEES & BOOKING
