Transport to the Island is by ferry from Sandspit Wharf and a bus will be chartered to take campers from Auckland (Smales Farm bus terminal on the North Shore) to the ferry. ACTIVITIES

The camps provide a full programme of indoor and outdoor activities together with meetings for Bible teaching and discussion. There will also be ample time at camp just to sit around, chat, play board-games and enjoy other informal activities.
