letter to the Philippians and are being encouraged in the Gospel of Jesus Christ and challenged to render the love and obedience worthy of such a Saviour. We are also in the process of looking carefully at our outreach activities to see how we can better reach the community with the gospel and also make the church more visible by way of advertising of different forms: a number of people who now attend the church first came to know about us through our web site.
